

Section B -YOUTH BEEF CATTLE

Tuesday, 9:00 AM

Required 4-H age is 8 years old as of January 1, current year

Junior Heifer calf – born on or after January 1 of current year.

Senior Heifer calf – born between September 1 and December 31 of preceding year.

Late Summer Yearling Heifer – born between July 1 & August 31 of preceding year.

Summer Yearlings Heifer – born between May 1 and Aug. 31 of preceding year.

Spring Yearlings Heifer – born between March 1 & April 30 of preceding year.

Junior Yearlings Heifer – born between January 1 & last day of February of preceding year. Senior Yearlings Heifer – born between September 1 and December 31 of 2 year ago.

Cow w/natural calf at side, calf – born after January 1 of current year.

Junior Bull Calf – born on or after January 1 of current year.

Senior Bull Calf – born between September 1 and December 31 of preceding year. Yearling Bull – born between January 1 & August 31 of preceding year.

Bulls 6 months or older must have a nose lead or nose ring. **Unmanageable animals may be excused at discretion of Beef Superintendent.** Late Fair entries may show for ribbons only. Exhibitors will be limited to 2 exhibits per class.

MARKET BEEF STEERS OR HEIFERS (NOT IN SALE)

Awards: Blue-\$12, Red-\$10, Yellow-\$8

Animals entered here must not be shown in other 4-H or FFA classes. Males must be properly castrated. Stags and short scrotum animals are ineligible. **ALL MUST BE PROPERLY DEHORNED OR POLLED.** Except feeder classes, all must have been born during the preceding year. All must have been fed by the exhibitor.

Awards: Blue-\$12, Red-\$10, Yellow-\$8

Owners must help weigh animals - 3:00 to 5:00 PM Sunday. Judge may designate classes according to numbers, maturity or degree of finish.

- B850 Feeder weight, less than 800 pounds
- B851 Intermediate weight, 801 to 999 pounds
- B852 Market weight, 1000 pounds minimum

LIVESTOCK FITTING & SHOWMANSHIP FOR BEEF

Awards: Blue - \$12, Red - \$10, Yellow - \$8

All Youth (8-19 yrs. Old) beef exhibitors must enter. Each contestant must show his or her own animal, but during the course of the contest may be asked by the judge to show another animal in that class. Members must prepare their animals without major assistance of parents or other adults.

NOTE: Classes may be divided into Novice, Junior, Intermediate and Senior sections at the discretion of the Superintendent. (NOVICE – has not shown before and is under 14 yrs as of Jan.1)
