- 3. Birds must be in show quality conditions: clean, healthy, vigorous, mature, and fully feathered.
- 4. Poultry are checked in Sunday between 10:00 and 3:00. No bird will be allowed in the coops until after it has been inspected by the Poultry Superintendent. This is mainly a precaution to eliminate birds with lice, mites, or undesirable poultry.
- 5. Rules and restrictions will be mailed upon receipt of fair entry.
