Allegany County Fair Annual Demolition Derby 2024

Rules for Drivers

- 1. The driver of the vehicle must be 18 years or older and hold a valid driver's license or Sheriff issued Id. However, 16 and 17 old drivers may participate with a minor release signed by a parent or legal guardian. The minors release MUST be signed and witnessed by a demolition derby official at the time of registration.
- 2. All drivers must wear long pants (NO SHORTS). Full body protection is required.
- 3. All drivers MUST wear a seat belt, helmet and eye protection, all of which must be worn at all times while on the track. Neck braces and roll over bars are suggested but not required.
- 4. NO smoking is allowed on the track or in any vehicle on the track at any time
- 5. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES are allowed on the premises at any time. Anyone found in violation will be removed.
- 6. Children under the age of **16** will NOT be allowed in the pit area, unless they are driving in the youth demo in which the parent or legal guardian must accompany them. Any other children will be asked to leave. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
- 7. Only demo vehicles will be allowed in the pit area. You may bring tools in but then you are required to take your vehicle out of the pit area. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
- 8. All demo vehicles MUST be removed by the end of the next day of the demo. Vehicles left on the property will then become property of Allegany County Agricultural Society.
- 9 The Allegany County Agricultural Society or the Whitesville Fire Dept. shall not be responsible for the cars or for property stolen from cars. Stealing vehicles or parts from vehicles will be reported to the police. Any driver not obeying these rules will be disqualified. The decision of the track officials will be FINAL!!!
- 10. Participants of the Derby may not be employee of the track or the fair association.
- 11. The Promoters reserve the right to approve or reject any or all entries.
- 12. Heat winners may use another Heat car in the feature if his/her car is inoperable or unsafe to participate.
- 13. ALL ENTRANTS MUST BE RESIDENTS OF ALLEGANY, STEUBEN, LIVINGSTON, WYOMING, CATTARAUGUS, POTTER AND MCKEAR COUNTIES WITH A VALID ID. AND VERIFICATION OF ADDRESS MUST BE PROVIDED.
- 14. TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR STATE FINALS YOU MUST BE AN ALLEGANY COUNTY RESIDENT.

Rules for Modified V-8, Compact,

- 1. Any 2 door or 4 door automobile or station wagon will be allowed. NO limos, ambulances, hearses, Chrysler imperials, School buses, or any other commercial vehicle will be allowed. NO 03 and up FOMOCO 2. Windshield and all glass must be removed NO EXCEPTIONS!!!.
- 3. Sun visors, windshield wipers, all lights, mirrors, all chrome/moldings, door handles, antennas, and broken glass MUST be removed.
- 4. Two 5/16"x1" flat stock or the 5/16" diameter rods must be secured at the top and bottom of the windshield area to prevent the hood from injuring the driver. (Bars can be welded at the top and bottom).
- 5. Vehicles MUST have a full bench seat or two bucket seats in the front of the car. (If a four point cage is present only one bucket seat is required).

Doors and trunks may be welded 3in on and 3 in off.

- 6. 4 point cage is allowed. Maximum of 6 inch diameter material. Minimum of 4 inch. No Rear window bars.
- 7. Gas tank protector 24inches wide. Minimum of 6inches space between protector and back seat.
- 8. Halo Bar allowed 4 inch maximum pipe. NO Turn outs
- 9. Interior tank MUST be secured with a minimum of two straps and must be covered with a fire proof shield. If the exterior tank cannot be removed it MUST be punctured to remove fuel (NO dumping fuel on the ground). ANY FUEL LEAK WILL CALL FOR IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION. NO more than 5 gallons of gas allowed.
- 10. Batteries may be left in the vehicle in front of the firewall in the original location. Battery may be removed and placed in the passenger area and must be securely fastened to the floor with at least 2 straps and Must be covered with a non-metallic cover.

- 11. All doors, hood, and trunk must be securely fastened with chains, seat belts, or no more than 4 fasteners on each cut off flush.
- 12. Two 8" diameter (minimum) holes one on each side of the hood over the engine compartment are required NO protruding metal.
- 13. One 4" inspection hole in the trunk lid required NO protruding metal.
- 14. Cooling system may be left in or taken out. No anti-freeze/coolant allowed. Cooling system must be flushed (no dumping on the ground) ONLY CLEAR WATER NO EXCEPTION. Fan blade MUST be **removed** if not protected by a **fan shroud**.
- 15. Tilting of frame allowed 6 inch spacer allowed at the core support.
- 16. All vehicles must have functional brakes.
- 17. You may hard nose and do bumper swaps. Nothing more than 6 Inches of metal may be used to weld bumper on. NO reinforcement or NO trailer hitches allowed. May swap out bumper but see 17C for more specific rules. Maybe Seamed welded but end need to remain open. No welding past Core Support. Core support bolts can be 3/4" and all other bolts (like body mounts) no larger than 1/2". No more than 6" of metal can be in frame, welded or not weld. Frames will be drilled and inspected further if judges believe they are questionable.
- 17A. Fix it plates are for pre-run cars only and if putting on fix-it plates, welds cannot touch. Fix it plates 4in X 6in maximum 2 per frame rail, Rust repair is separate and needs to be called on.
- 17B. No foam in frames.
- 17C. Bumpers front and rear maybe 4" X 6" X 3/16" wall with max 4" point over 32' bumper. Bumper can only be as wide as center to center of front tires. Ends maybe capped but MUST have 1" hole in each end (NO stuffing). This is for all Classes
- 18. Suspension may be stiff. Leaf spring swaps allowed. ½ ton springs max. 5 leafs per a pack. 4 clamps per leaf.
- 19. Trailing arms may be replaced with 2 inch by 2 inch box metal
- 20 .Lower engine cradle may be used to mount engine in cradle. Pulley protector allowed.
- 21. ONLY the driver's door is to be painted YELLOW and with NO writing.
- 22. Numbers will be assigned at registration and must be painted on both doors and roof of the vehicle (please make it legible).
- 23. NO obscene writing allowed on the vehicle.
- 24. Body mounts can be removed but factory size hardware must be used to remount the body to the frame, in the factory locations 4 extra body bolts may be used.
- 25. Any holes in the fire wall MUST be covered with rubber/sheet metal.
- 26. ANY WELDS NOT DEEMED SAFE BY AN INSPECTOR WILL BE TOLD TO CUT.
- 27. GOODIES; Sliders allowed, steering columns, pedals, shifter, steel bell only no braces, trans coolers, lower puller proctors, tie rods with factory style ends, small wheel centers . NO DISTRIBUTOR PROTECTOR, NO TRANSMISSION BRACE, NO SLIDER DRIVESHAFT, NO BRACED REAR ENDS. If it's not on the list it's not allowed at this time.
- 28. Tires. No V tread, No skid-steer tires on drive tires. Nothing over the top aggressive and that's the judge's decision. Wheel weights must be removed. No alterations to wheel rims or attachments to rims allowed. No doubled, foam filled, liquid filled tires or Split rims can be used. No valve stem protector.
- 29. Compacts with carb.swab can run carb.protection only mounted to the top of the engine, nothing else and may not add support to anything in anyway.

Rules for Trucks, Vans, And SUV'S Same Rules Apply to Economy <u>plus The Following</u>

- 1.Two-wheel drive or four wheel drive vehicles (if running a four wheel drive either the front or rear driveshaft MUST be removed).
- 2. Back window MUST be wire mesh.
- 3. No hitches or other reinforcements.
- 4. Fuel tanks MUST be boat type behind the cab inside the frame rails and they MUST be fully covered.
- 5. Tailgates MUST be bolted, chained, wired, or removed.

Simple stock class for V8 and 4+6 class.

Anything outside these rules will not run in stock class

- 1. All glass and molding must be removed (including windshield)
- 2. Front window bars or wire is mandatory
- 3. No rear window bars
- 4. 1980 or newer car
- 5. Can hard nose up to 4 inches any OEM bumper (no shortening of frame) (no homemade bumpers)
- 6. May have back seat bar or strap (No 4 point cage)
- 7. Stock motor, Transmission, cross member and rear end
- 8. DOT tires only

- 9. You can weld the rear Diff. if you would like.
- 10.Battery can be moved to the front passenger floor if you would like.
- 11.Gas tank can be moved to rear seat and covered (no tank protectors)
- 12. No aftermarket shifter.
- 13. No aftermarket gas or brake pedal
- 14. You may notch the rear frame.
- 15. You may chain the rear end.
- 16. Chain or No9 wire on doors, hood and trunk. (no welding)

 fee \$50 includes driver. 1 run and done \$250 plus 2ft. trophy.

Stock 4+6 cylinder class (Must have at least 6 cars to run this class) Entry fee \$50 includes driver. 1 run and done \$250 plus 2ft. trophy.

Junk anything that runs car, truck, vans, SUV. Entry fee \$50 includes driver

1 run and done \$250 plus 2ft trophy

All 1st place heat winners will receive a 2ft trophy
